Professional appearing on behalf of the applicant has submitted that the applicant paid compounding fee with Ministry of Corporate Affairs Portal instead of depositing through Demand Draft in favour of "The Pay & Accounts Officer, Ministry of Corporate Affairs", payable at New Delhi.

2. In view of the submissions made by the professional appearing on behalf of the applicant, though the payment ultimately reaches the Ministry of Corporate Affairs, but for there being a procedure to pay compounding fee in favour of 'Pay & Accounts Officer, Ministry of Corporate Affairs, this Bench directs the applicant to pay the compounding fee in favour of Pay & Accounts Officer, Ministry of Corporate Affairs by way of Demand Draft payable at New Delhi, with liberty to apply for refund of the money that has already been paid through MCA Portal, within 10 days.

3. It is made clear that for there being a procedure of making payment of compounding fee in favour of Pay & Accounts Officer, Ministry of Corporate Affairs, New Delhi, to avoid such precedent to deposit by different modes which will not show payment of compounding fee under one head, the request of the applicant is rejected.
